

The Municipal and ISD Election is an official non-partisan contest but remains dominated between Candidates who are affiliated with Political Parties. The foSAFA Committee looks first and foremost at Candidates based on their commitment to life, liberty, marriage, family, legitimate defense, and free markets, and then secondarily at their Party affiliation. Considering the Platforms of the Parties currently, the Republican Party is the Platform closest to Pro-Life, Liberty, Marriage, Family, Legitimate Defense, and Free Markets that will lead to individual human flourishing and long-term domestic prosperity. Take this into account on races where no recommendation exists. Also, uncontested races might not be listed due to space issues.

Vote on Election Day to minimize any potential vote manipulation.

Right of Voter To Vote After Time Poll Closes - Texas Statute Sec. 41.032. VOTING AFTER POLLS CLOSE.
